Students must cooperate with the following practices, so that we can continue to provide classes safely:

- 1. Please register for classes, but do not attend in-person classes on a day you are not feeling well.
- 2. Wear a face covering while in our facility.
- 3. Sanitize your hands as soon as you enter a building.
- 4. Register for classes by phone or online.
- 5. Remain in your classroom as much as is possible (bathrooms will, of course, be open).
- 6. Keep a safe 6 feet away from others.
- 7. Allow a JobLink staff member to take your temperature before attending a class. Return home or see if doctor you have a temperature at or above 100.4°.
