Sisters and Brothers.

The ArcelorMittal USA Facilities sale to Cleveland Cliffs is still in progress. Cleveland Cliffs management are continuing their due diligence by visiting the ArcelorMittal Cleveland plants and the ArcelorMittal Eastern Plate facilities. Just like here at Indiana Harbor & Riverdale, the word is that Cleveland Cliffs likes what they see! It is expected that the United States Justice Department should be rendering an opinion sometime around Thanksgiving.

Unfortunately, as expected, a new Indiana executive order will start this weekend to limit crowd sizes to 25 people in the highest-risk Indiana counties and a 50 people limit in the next-riskiest counties. Any crowd larger than 50 will require approval by local health officials. This new executive order will also limit capacity at K-12 indoor sports and extracurricular events with religious services being the only exception. Governor Holcomb also extended the Indiana statewide mask mandate for another month.

Since late September, Indiana hospitals have seen a 200% increase in COVID-19 patients and the seven-day rolling average of deaths has jumped from 10 a day to 38. The increased COVID-19 case load has strained hospitals around the state, threatens to exceed their bed capacity and has begun to overwhelm their health care staffs.

On this past Wednesday, Indiana health officials confirmed 31 more deaths to Indiana's pandemic toll, raising it to 4,762 fatalities, which includes confirmed and presumed coronavirus infections since March. These are facts that dictate that the public needs to take the virus spread more seriously while waiting for approval and distribution of COVID-19 Vaccines.

I encourage all of us to stay the course of keeping our hands cleaned, maintaining 6' or more of social distancing, and utilizing masks or face coverings. All of these actions can help prevent and/or slowdown the spread of this terrible pandemic.

It is for our well-being that we follow in plant recommendations on hand cleanliness, surface cleaning, social distancing, wearing of masks, and daily self-monitoring. We can only benefit from following these safe practices at home, in public and at work. We are all affected by the health and wellbeing of each other. Let's do our best to support each other and our families by adhering to CDC recommendations regarding the prevention of spreading COVID-19! We have all heard the horror stories of friends, relatives and yes, our retirees that have died as a result of the Covid-19 Virus. Together, we can minimize the chances of us being added to the list of those stricken with Covid-19.

According to management, the operations will remain at about the same level of operations next week: Our Riverdale Facility will continue production. At Indiana Harbor East (IHE), overall operations will maintain production levels. According to IHE Management this includes, 80" Hot Strip, #4 Steel Production, #3 Cold Strip facilities- #3CAL Line, 80" Tandem, #5 Pickle Line and the 29 Temper Mill.
