To Local 1010 Members:

Sisters and Brothers,

Here in Northwest Indiana, we must continue to fight the COVID-19 Pandemic as the Corona Virus data is not looking much better. Earlier this week, the state reported 2 new COVID-19 deaths in Lake County bringing the total to 251 just in Lake County. There were over a dozen new deaths recorded across Indiana, bringing the state's total to nearly 2,600. Even this data is incomplete because of all the reported data lags behind and is considered provisional and subject to change as more information continues to be reported to the state. There were 87 new positive cases reported Tuesday in Lake County for a total of 5,764, 15 in Porter County for a total of 891, 10 in LaPorte County for a total of 639, and six in Jasper County for a total of 142. Newton County's case count remained at 101 on Tuesday. The data shows that this Coronavirus is still a major threat to our families' lives and health.

Consistent with Center for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines, we have in plant recommendations on social distancing, wearing of masks, and daily self-monitoring. It is to our own and our families benefit to follow safe practices at home, in public and at work. We are all affected by the health and wellbeing of each other. Let's do our best to support each other and our families by adhering to CDC recommendations regarding the prevention of spreading COVID-19!

According to management, there are just a few changes to the operations for the Week of September 20th Operations:

- Our Riverdale Facility will continue production with operations at 4 crews. Coming soon to Riverdale is a planned maintenance outage which is scheduled for October.
- At Indiana Harbor East (IHE), overall operations will be at the same production levels for the week of September 20th. According to IHE Management, #4 Steel Production, 80" Hot Strip Mill, #3 Cold Strip facilities including the 29 Temper Mill, #5 Pickle Line, and 80" Tandem will maintain operations. The #3 CAL Line is scheduled to run next week and continue on its rotation based on order and substrate availability. The 80" Hot Strip Mill will transition back to 4 operating crews next week. We still do not know for how long it will run at 4 crews, but obviously it is a good sign for all of us. We will keep everyone in the loop if we have any more information regarding operational changes.
